SILENT PARTNER STORY

In 1979, Carole Webb moved with her husband, Chuck to Minaki Detachment in this remote locale. The Webb family lived in the residence at detachment for the four years Chuck was posted there.

Carole assisted around the office in many ways. She often cared for the prisoners while waiting for the guards to arrive. When there were no personnel at detachment she dealt with people who came to the door. She regularly made coffee for the various visitors, and provided meals for the prisoners.

She was an asset in the community as well. Occasionally she cared for children who needed assistance and she also tended to injured people until ambulances or care workers arrived from Kenora.

As Chuck fittingly put it, “Carole certainly was an asset to me and to the detachment members.”

About Minaki

Minaki is a small, unincorporated community in northern Ontario, about a 55 kilometer drive north of Kenora. Minaki is gateway to lakes and rivers of the Ontario portion of the Winnipeg River system, including Gun, Sand, Pistol and Roughrock lakes. Fly-in service is available to the English River and lakes farther north.
