SILENT PARTNER STORY

With about a two-week notice, we moved from Atikokan to Nestor Falls in April of 1967. Nestor Falls was a one-man detachment. Larry had so many calls in the middle of the night that by the end of our year he was answering the phone even when it wasn't ringing. Days off were unheard of, unless you left town.

The detachment was a rented house with the office and garage on the bottom floor and our living quarters on the second. Our first two children were ages one and three when we moved to Nestor Falls in the spring of 1967.

Larry was away a lot, even having to take his mail to Emo. I think Sioux Narrows took the calls. I remember one incident of note while he was away. Some people came into my kitchen dripping blood all over the floor after having been involved in a traffic collision. I don't even remember what I did, but we got through it.

Nestor Falls had no jail cell, so I didn't usually have to make meals for prisoners.

About Nester Falls
