**SILENT PARTNER STORY**

Constable Horne and his wife Ann lived and worked in Smooth Rock Falls while raising their family. When they first arrived, it was a one-man detachment but soon became a two-man detachment. On the detachment property, there was an office and two dwellings.

On many occasions and almost a daily routine, Ann was called upon to assist her husband by taking care of the office and two adjacent houses.

As part of her duties, Ann was responsible for checking on prisoners at any time, day or night; preparing and serving prisoner meals and on occasion supplying food and lodging to transients who would otherwise go hungry.

She took care of the washing and cleaning of the detachment's one cruiser, maintaining the office, answering the radio and phone, filing, acting as a guard for both male and female prisoners, greeting the public, shovelling the snow and cutting the grass.

Mrs. Ann Horne did everything called upon and more. Ann should be recognized for her patience and endurance while supporting her husband Gordy and the OPP and raising a family at the same time.
